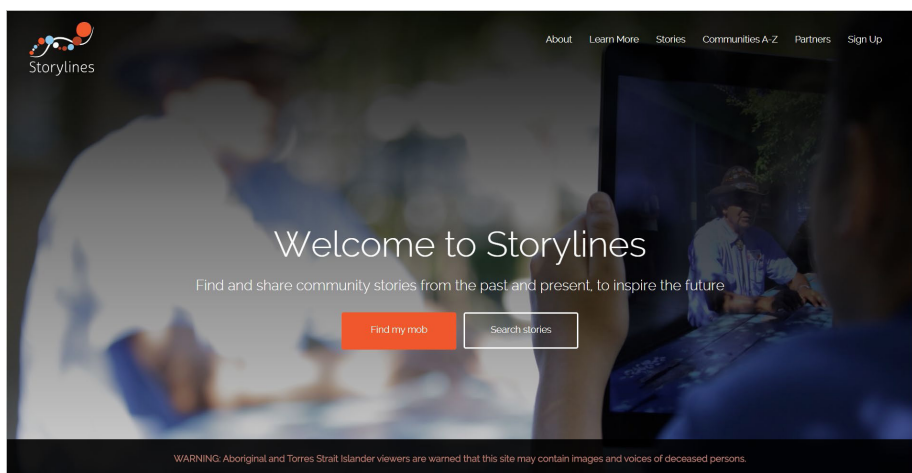
Storylines

The Storylines platform provides local community members, schools, organisations, and the broader community with a culturally safe online environment to share and celebrate Aboriginal, non-secret, non-sacred stories of history, culture and achievement. Storylines represents a tapestry of individual localised community websites accessible at www.storylines.com.au

Within NSW, each site is connected to a local Aboriginal Education Consultative Group (AECG), enabling local Community ownership and approval of all content shared.

Uploading your Branyi Bayann Niiringal stories to Storylines

- 1) Navigate to www.stoylines.com.au



- 2) Select **Communities A-Z** from the top navigation menu or **Find my mob**, center of home page.
- 3) Search for your local Storylines website by typing in the name of your geographical location or the Aboriginal country name where your school resides. Select your community's site then select **Submit a story** from the left-hand navigation menu.

If there is no local Storylines website in your area, select **Submit a story** from the top navigation menu to upload your story. A Storylines representative will be in touch to assist you in finding the appropriate community to share your story with and/or work with you, your community and local AECG to establish a Storylines site.

- 4) After selecting **Submit a story** fill in your relevant contact details, upload content and then select **Submit**.
- 5) You will receive an email within **24-72** hours when your newly created story is ready to be reviewed in a private Storylines consultation area. If adjustments are required, simply reply to the notification email, or contact the storylines team by phone on **02 9057 8000** with any changes required.
- 6) The connected local AECG will be notified of your new story and be able to view the story within the private Storylines consultation area. Some stories may be approved instantly, others may require direct communication with your local AECG and/or you may be required to present the stories via the consultation area at your next local AECG meeting to achieve approval. Consultation and approval may take some time, and further adjustments to your story may be required. It's best practice to start the consultation process with your local AECG and local Community prior to starting your Branyi Bayann Niiringal program.
- 7) Your local AECG will approve and publish the uploaded story making it publicly available on your local Storylines community site. A local AECG representative does this by selecting the publish button from within the private consultation area or by contacting the Storylines team. You will be notified once the story is publicly available on your local Storylines Community Site.
